Three Ways to Live Out Sunday's Message from Pastor Jon

This past week we discovered that God's Will is wholeness for our lives and for all of creation. This is God's gift to us each day. As you live towards wholeness, here are three ways you could live that out this week.

Speak Life into Dry Bones

Identify one place in your life—or in someone else's—that feels hopeless. Pray over it each day this week and intentionally speak words of hope rather than despair.

Become a Sign of the New Creation

Perform one act that reflects God's coming Kingdom: reconcile with someone, serve a neighbor, care for creation, visit someone lonely, or encourage someone who has lost hope.

Live with Resurrection Hope

Each morning this week, begin your day by praying: "Lord Jesus, help me live today as someone who believes You are making all things new." Let that hope shape your words, your decisions, and your relationships.

Sometimes it can be difficult to know how to live as a follower of Jesus in today's world. Our sense of identity can feel uncertain, and division and brokenness often seem to surround us. Yet God offers a different vision for who we are and how we are called to live together.
